An anonymous member supplied the newsletter with a copy of a handwritten note by Levi Biddle, (active 1850s-1890s) of Shanesville/Sugarcreek in Tuscarawas county to a student. The script and style of illustrations are typical of the mid-to late 19th century and the execution reflects Biddle's artistic and educational accomplishments. This letter gives insight into the personality and skills of a regional Ohio gunsmith from a well-known gunsmithing family who was also a school teacher. – Mark Bender
